PRODUCT INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS

THE BINDING, EVEN IF FITTED PROPERLY, MAY OR MAY NOT RELEASE IN A FALL WHICH COULD RESULT IN THE INJURY OF THE ANKLE, KNEE, LEG OR OTHER PARTS OF THE BODY. TO REDUCE THE RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH, FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:


USE CORRECT SIZE BOARD AND BINDING. BINDING SHOULD BE ADJUSTED FOR SNUG-NOT-TIGHT FIT.

- + Wet binding and feet with water before use.
- + Inspect wakeboard, fins and bindings for loose screws, wear, cracks, de-lamination or tearing.
- + Check foot straps (bindings) and fins prior to each use to insure they are fastened securely to the wakeboard.
- + The faster you wakeboard, the greater the risk of injury.

 Exercise additional caution when skiing at competitive speeds.

BEGINNERS SHOULD BE TOWED AT SLOWER SPEEDS THAT ALLOW FOR REASONABLE CONTROL AND STABILITY.

+ Wakeboarding instruction is recommended before use.
 Instruction will teach general safety guidelines and proper wakeboarding techniques, which may reduce risk of injury.



MOUNTING SLINGSHOT BINDINGS

BOARDS WITH INSERTS:


- + Place each binding on top of the board in your approximate desired stance.
- + One binding at a time, fit clamps onto each side of the baseplate, with the grooves in the clamp fitting over the teeth in the binding baseplate.
- + Line up the clamp grooves with the insert holes in your board, maintaining your desired stance width, duct and center on the board.
- + Your mounting hardware includes two washers- one is larger than the other. Starting with the larger washer, screw down the inside clamp using the insert hole that be match your stance. Keep it loose for now. Attach the outside clamp with the smalle washer, again using the appropriate insert hole.
- With both clamps loose, fine-tune your stance. The binding will rotate easer on the side with the smaller washer. When your stance is dialed, tighten both sides firmly by hand (no power tools), making sure the threads are seated properly.
- + Make sure all screws are tightened firmly prior to every session.

BOARDS WITH SLINGSHOT FASTRACK:

- + Fastrack hardware is sold separately.
- + Slide your T-bolts into the board's FASTRACK channels, two on each side.
- + Position bindings in your desired stance on the board.
- + Place binding clamp over the T-bolt, with the groove in the clamp seated onto the teeth in the binding baseplate.
- + Your mounting hardware includes two washers- one is larger than the other. Starting with the larger washer, screw down the inside clamp. Keep it loose for now. Attach the outside clamp with the smaller washer. Make sure the threads seat properly to prevent cross threading.
- + With both clamps loose, fine-tune your stance. The binding will rotate easier on the side with the smaller washer. When your stance is dialed, tighten both sides firmly by hand (no power tools), making sure the threads are seated properly.
- + Make sure all screws are tightened firmly prior to every session.

STANCE ADJUSTMENT

- + Find a stance width that is a comfortable width for your height.
- + Adjust the angle of your bindings to create a comfortable duck stance.
- + Make sure that the bindings are centered on the wakeboard.



PRODUCT MAINTENANCE

- + Never wax, paint or alter the bottom or rails of your board.
- + Wash your board and/or bindings with soap and fresh water, and rinse thoroughly, especially after using in salt water.
- + Always allow board and/or bindings to dry completely before storing, and always stow in dry storage.
- + DO NOT leave your board and/or bindings in the sun for long periods of time.
- + DO NOT use oils or lotions to get in the bindings. Most do not wash out and can cause damage to the binding materials.
- + Buy a protective bag for your board, it helps keep it from becoming scratched, damaged by the sun and may protect the boat as well.
- + Inspect your board for damage every time you ride. Also check the bindings for worn or damaged parts.
- Replace excessively worn or damaged parts before riding your board.
- $\mbox{+}$ Check the fins to make sure they are tight. Fins DO NOT float.
- + Make sure binding mounting screws are tight before every ride.
- + Never use Loctite® or other thread sealants on binding screws or fin screws.

ONE (1) YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

Slingshot warranties and obligations set forth below are in lieu of any other expressed warranties or obligations of Slingshot Wakeboards, its distributors, or retailers. The warranties and limitations extend to the original purchaser or to the person for whom originally purchased for. Slingshot's warranty extends for a period of ONE YEAR from date of purchase on all products except apparel. Apparel is not applicable to any warranties. Proof of purchase is required from an authorized Slingshot dealer. RECEIPT MUST CLEARLY IDENTIFY DEALER. Slingshot will, at manufacturer's option, repair or replace any wakeboard, kiteboard, or binding which exhibits defects in material or workmanship. REPAIRED OR REPLACED ITEMS ARE COVERED FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE ORIGINAL WARRANTY ONLY. SLINGSHOT WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER:

- + Cost of return shipping to Slingshot.
- + Normal wear and tear, including dents, dings, fading, nicks or scratches.
- + Any damage caused by sliders or rails.
- Damage caused by modifications and /or use of equipment not provided with the purchase of Slingshot products. This includes bolt-on systems to attach fins and bindings, cutting and reshaping boards, overlays and or binding parts, etc.
- + Damage to boards incurred while other manufacturer's bindings, and/or fins were in use.
- + Damage caused by misuse or an accident such as dock slides, dock or beach starts, striking a solid object, tow rope handle striking product, etc. The validity of damage or any like situation reports are at the discretion of Slingshot's warranty personnel. The above applies to boards, bindings, fins and inserts.
- + Products used in commercial, rental, demo, or instruction programs.

WARNINGS

WARNING! The sport of wakeboarding involves inherent risks of injury and death which cannot be completely eliminated.

To reduce risks:

- Wakeboarding instruction is recommended before use. Proper instruction should teach general safety guidelines and proper wakeboarding techniques, which may reduce risk of injury.
- · Always read, understand, and follow the directions in your owner's manual.
- Always familiarize yourself with all applicable federal, state, and local laws; the waterways and area; and the proper use of the equipment.
- Always have a person other than the boat operator as an observer and agree on a set of hand signals.
- Always inspect all equipment including the tow rope prior to each use.
 Never use any equipment with missing, damaged, or defective parts.
- Always wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved Type III flotation vest (PFD).
- Always ride in control and at speeds appropriate for your ability.
 Beginners should be towed at slower speeds that allow for reasonable control and stability.
- Attempting land or dock starts, or using man-made obstacles such as rails, sliders, and jumps, increases the risk of injury or death. USE THIS PRODUCT ONLY IN WATER.
- Never ride in shallow water or near shore, pilings, docks, rafts, swimmers, other watercraft, or other obstacles
- · Always use an appropriate size board and binding. Always adjust the bindings to your feet.
- Bindings should be adjusted for a snug, not tight fit. Be aware that bindings will not release from the board, and that your feet may or may not come out of the bindings in a fall.

- · Do not operate any watercraft or ride under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
